2025 Stewardship Campaign Update: Mike Shepherd

- Progress update
 - Goal = \$4,500,000 (Pledges \$3,500,000 + Other \$1,000,000).
 - As of Nov 18th = \$3,183,889 in Pledges (537).
 - Up 60% in number of pledges and up 50% in pledged dollars.
 - Forecast to achieve the goal.
 - \$211,744 in 2024 pledges that have not pledged yet to 2025.
