- Distributed a Diocesan report.
- Next Vestry election I recommend we consider a youth.
- General Convention meets every 3 years.
- This Sunday I will be teaching about stewardship.
- Bishop search committee is holding meetings to seek input on what qualities people are looking for in the next Bishop. Discussion on a few of the qualities we would like to see listener, pastoral, church planting where populations are growing.

Fall Stewardship Campaign: Mike Shepherd

- Shared a "Better Together" slideshow.
- This year the theme is "Love Heavenly, Live faithfully. Give together."
- Requested that all Vestry and clergy turn in their 2026 pledge cards.
- Progress after 1st of 8 weeks.
 - Goal \$4.8million with Pledges being \$3.8m.
 - As of today, we have \$1.185m pledged.
- Forecast to achieve the goal.
- Other relevant data.
- Engaging the audience bullet points.
- Potential activities post Nov 16th.

Wednesday Dinner Follow-Up: David Gagnon

- Is this dinner paying for itself? = Yes
- Should we use paper plates? = No, we have a scheduled individual to wash dishes.

- Should we serve alcohol? = Survey says no. Rector prefers alcohol free. Vestry agrees
- Ministry hosting could donate gift cards to help offset the cost.
- Childcare was the identified bottleneck for growth of this ministry. Proposed solution:
 - Preschool coverage in the nursery.
 - Need for another part-time person to add to the family ministry. That person would work 9 10 hours per week doing various activities to support Youth Ministry, and would also help support Amy Schmidt for non-preschool children during Wednesday nights.
 - Vestry agrees with making the investment in childcare for Wed Night Dinner.

Strategic Plan Development Update: Jim Evanger

- Doing really well with our Strategic Plan update.
- Looking forward 5yrs.
- Creating measurable goals and kick starting specific tactics.
- We are in final draft mode and will do a stress test with the clergy and staff.
- Reached out to over a 100 parishioners to get feedback to work on the plan.
