As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man called Matthew sitting at the tax booth; and he said to him, “Follow me.”

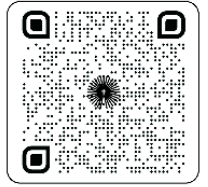
